In January 2010 the AA will launch its Global School at the School of Architecture of the Catholic University in Santiago de Chile, one of most rapidly changing capital cities in South America. The intensive ten-day studio-based design workshop is open to students, young architects and other designers worldwide.

In Chile the construction of a new sports infrastructure to house the 2014 Pan-American Olympics – ODESUR – is being treated as an unparalleled opportunity to transform a range of environments. By taking a critical look at the ambitious plans currently under development, and proposing design alternatives, the workshop aims at defining strategies applicable at different scales. Participants will approach this project by integrating different fields of architectural action. This design research will encourage explorations ranging through material properties, construction processes, parametric design and digital fabrication, right up to the urban and landscape scales, taking account of the local cultures and Chile's spectacular landscape.

The course will be taught by tutors from the AA School and the Catholic University. Eva Castro (AA Landscape Urbanism), Hanif Kara (AA Design Research Lab), Monia De Marchi (AA Diploma Unit 9), and Alejandra Bosch (AA Landscape Urbanism) will join Rodrigo Pérez de Arce, Arturo Lyon and Pedro Ignacio Alonso.

En Enero 2010 la Architectural Association, en conjunto con la Escuela de Arquitectura de la Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, dará inicio a su Escuela Visitante en Santiago, una de las capitales más dinámicas y atractivas de Sudamérica. Este será un workshop intensivo de 10 días y estará abierto a estudiantes de arquitectura, arquitectos y diseñadores de todo el mundo.

En Chile la construcción de nueva infraestructura deportiva para albergar los Juegos Panamericanos ODESUR 2014 surge como una oportunidad única para investigar estrategias de diseño innovadoras. A partir de una revisión acuciosa de los planes actualmente en curso, este workshop propondrá un acercamiento al diseño de infraestructura deportiva en sus distintas escalas, incentivando una aproximación que irá desde propiedades materiales, procesos constructivos, diseño paramétrico y fabricación digital, hasta la escala urbana y del paisaje, tomando en cuenta la cultura arquitectónica local y la dimensión geográfica de Chile.

Este curso estará dirigido por profesores de la Architectural Association y de la Escuela de Arquitectura de la Universidad Católica de Chile. Eva Castro (Landscape Urbanism AA), Hanif Kara (AA Design Research Lab), Monia De Marchi (AA Diploma Unit 9) and Alejandra Bosch (AA Landscape Urbanism) trabajarán en conjunto con Rodrigo Pérez de Arce, Arturo Lyon y Pedro Ignacio Alonso, de la Universidad Católica.
