

Honorary Membership of the Architectural Association

Nominations Procedure

The By-Laws of the Architectural Association, Inc. include the following provision:

The Council may elect as Honorary Members, illustrious or distinguished persons, as from time to time they may determine, without subscription. These shall have the same rights as Members, and shall be limited in number to one hundred. (By-Law 13).

Persons nominated for the award of Honorary Membership should meet one of the following two criteria:

- Outstanding contribution to the work and development of the Architectural Association
- Outstanding contribution to architectural education, the architectural profession or associated arts in areas of particular relevance to the purposes and interests of the Architectural Association

Nomination procedure

Nominations for Honorary Membership may come from any member of the Architectural Association, and should be seconded by another member; nominees are not required to hold membership of the Architectural Association. It is suggested that nominations are supported by biographical information, personal testimonies, letters of support, etc.

Selection of Honorary Members is made twice yearly by the General Purposes Committee of the AA Council. The Committee recommends its selection to Council for review and approval. Once selected and approved, Honorary Members are contacted to confirm their acceptance. Until this point, nominations are strictly confidential. Only the names of those who have confirmed acceptance will be disclosed.
