

HOW TO CONNECT TO THE AA WIRELESS NETWORK (AA-WLAN)

WINDOWS XP (SERVICE PACK 3 OR LATER)

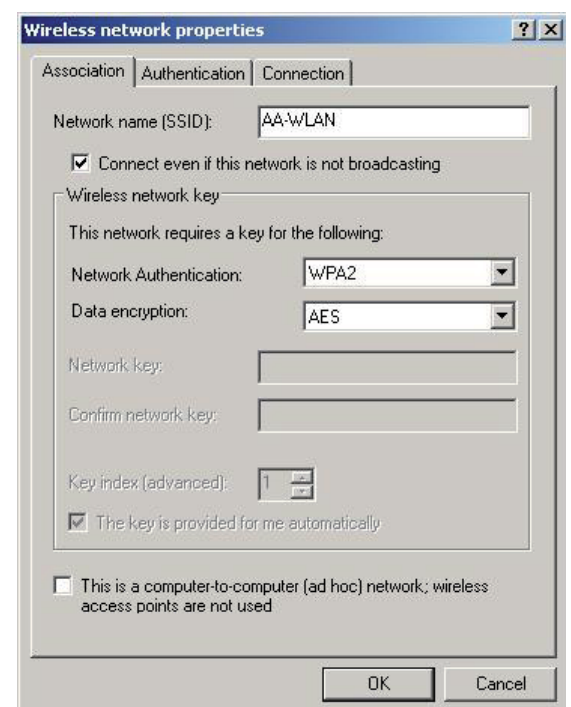
Click the **Start** button, right-click **My Network Places**, and choose **Properties** from the drop down menu. In the **Network Connections** window, right-click your wireless network icon and choose **Properties** from the drop down menu.



In the **Wireless Network Connection Properties** window, click the **Wireless Networks** tab. If this tab is not available, another utility is managing your wireless network settings – please see a member of the support team for assistance. The **Use Windows to Configure My Wireless Network Settings** checkbox should be already ticked. Clicking the **Add** button should open another window.



In the **Network Name (SSID)** field, type in **AA-WLAN** (in capital letters), and tick the **Connect Even If the Network Is Not Broadcasting** checkbox. Change the **Network Authentication** to **WPA2**. The Data Encryption should already be set to **AES**.



In the **Authentication** tab, clear the **Authenticate as Computer When Computer Information Is Available** checkbox (the **Enable IEEE 802.1x Authentication for This Network**

checkbox should be already ticked). Change the **EAP type** to **Protected EAP (PEAP)**, and click Properties.

In the **Protected EAP Properties** window, clear the **Validate server certificate** checkbox. The **Enable Fast Reconnect** checkbox should be already ticked. The **Authentication Method** should be **Secured Password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)**. Click **Configure**, and a smaller window, titled **EAP MSCHAPv2 Properties**, should appear. Clear the **Automatically Use My Windows Logon Name and Password (And Domain If Any)** checkbox, and click OK.

Click **OK** in the **Protected EAP Properties** window, click **OK** in the **Wireless Network Properties** window, and click **OK** in the **Wireless Network Connection Properties** window. In a few moments, a speech bubble should appear in the bottom right corner of your screen. Clicking on it will bring up a window asking you for your user credentials. Type in your username, adding **@aaschool.ac.uk** at the end (for example, **sam.smith@aaschool.ac.uk**), and password in the fields provided (please leave the last field blank). Clicking **OK** will connect you to **AA- WLAN**.
