

# AA School 2012/13 Undergraduate School Scholarships and Bursaries

### Scholarships for new students

The Architectural Association offers a large number of one- and two-term scholarships to **new UK and international students** entering the First, Second and Fourth Years of the AA School's five-year ARB/RIBA-accredited undergraduate course. British students who are new to the AA and entering Fourth Year are also eligible for a full-fee scholarship.

### Bursaries for current students

Bursaries – usually equivalent to one third of the fees – are available for **current AA undergraduate students** (date for applications to be announced in Term 2). Scholarship and bursary awards are based on a combination of outstanding merit and financial need.

### Loans

If you wish to enter the AA undergraduate school and have been living in the UK or EU for three years prior to embarking on higher education, you may also be eligible for a tuition fee loan of £3,375 (non-income assessed). Combined with a two-term AA scholarship, this would reduce annual tuition costs at the AA to around £2,232 per year. ### Financial assistance

The AA is deeply committed to maintaining tuition fees at a level that makes the school accessible to as many students as possible. Currently the AA provides around one in six of its students with some form of assistance through its scholarship, bursary or assistantship programmes. Many other students receive financial assistance from organisations or governments in their home countries.
