THE EDEN SCHOLARSHIP

The Eden Scholarship, worth £7,500 in tuition fees, is awarded to a UK applicant on the AA Graduate School's 12-month Master of Science (MSc) or the 16-month Master of Architecture (MArch) in Sustainable Environmental Design. The Eden Scholarship is sponsored by Grimshaw Architects, structural engineers Anthony Hunt Associates, environmental engineers Arup, quantity surveyors David Langdon & Everest and Eden Project Ltd.

The first of five annual Eden Scholarships was awarded in 2004-05 to Joy-Anne Fleming who successfully completed her Masters degree in September 2005 and is currently working full-time with Grimshaw Architects. The 2005-06 holder of the Eden Scholarship is Giles Bruce currently registered for the MArch in Sustainable Environmental Design due to complete in January 2007. For 2006-07 the Scholarship was awarded to Anya Thomas starting on the MArch in October 2006.

Applications are now welcome for 2007-08. Applicants for the Eden Scholarship must first secure a place on the AA Graduate School's MSc or MArch in Sustainable Environmental Design.
