This fourth annual AA Shanghai Summer School will be hosted at the University of Hong Kong Faculty of Architecture Shanghai Study Centre. In an intensive nine-day studio-based course, the city will be investigated through new computational design approaches in architecture and urbanism.

Growth & Change

This year's topic and site is the 5.3 km² area developed for the Shanghai 2010 Expo, focusing on proposals for the site after the Expo event. Situated in central Shanghai, it will be the largest Expo ever, yet will run for only six months. We will confront the limitations of the Expo's short-term legacy and its context by engaging in the complexities of an evolutionary urbanism.

In the first stage of a two-phase programme taught by AA tutors and invited guests, parametric design systems will be introduced in a series of intensive sessions as the basis for investigating associative design concepts and methodologies. In a second stage, these new tools will target the creation of dynamic architectural scenarios and urban models generated in relation to the

Shanghai Expo site. Design teams will apply code-based modelling, simulation and fabrication techniques, towards multiple, variable and recursive prototypes for a range of new cultural, commercial and civic facilities, driven by scenarios of future incremental, adaptive growth and change. In addition to design studio tutoring, the programme will include a range of computational and theoretical seminars, a conference with invited lecturers and an inclusive Expo site visit.

Accommodation & Costs

Accommodation during the workshop is not provided, but accommodation at an affordable hotel can be advised. Fees do not include flights or accommodation. Participants are recommended to bring their own laptops, digital equipment and model making tools.

第四届英国伦敦建筑联盟上海暑期学校将于近期在香港大学建筑系上海研究中心举办。在历时九天的课程期间, 通过安排紧凑的工作室研习, 学生将运用全新的数字化设计方法, 从建筑和城市的角度来解剖上海这个城市的样本。

增长和变化

今年暑期学校的研究课题为2010上海世博会会址, 面积为5.3平方公里, 关注点为基地在世博会之后的再利用问题。坐落在上海市中心, 这届世博会将成为有史以来最为宏大的一届盛会, 然而这届盛会的持续期只有六个月。世博会展期的临时性和地段的特殊性, 对我们提出了复杂动态城市性的挑战。

在划分为两个阶段的课程中, 第一阶段将由建筑联盟的老师将和客座教师一道, 通过一系列紧凑安排的课程来介绍参数化设计的基础, 以此来帮助学生理解探索关联整体设计的概念和

方法。在课程的第二个阶段, 学生将运用新近习得的工具和方法, 探索如何在世博会基地上设计符合场地特质的动态建筑场景和城市模型。学生将采用以脚本编程为基础的模式, 表现和加工手段, 尝试建立一个多重变化和往复循环的样本原型, 以此来联系一系列文化, 商业和市民公共设施, 并尝试把这个原型演化为一个具有自改进和自适应能力的, 面向未来的样本。在工作组的课程之外, 暑期学校还将安排一系列关注算法和理论的研讨会, 一场由邀请嘉宾出席的讲座和世博会会址基地参观。

申请方法

申请截止日期为2010年7月31日; 截止期过后的申请唯有在仍有名额的情况下才会得到考虑。
