Born in Warsaw in 1926, Joseph Rykwert is one of the best-known critics and historians of architecture. One of very few writers to be awarded the RIBA's highest honour, the Royal Gold Medal (2014) and author of countless books and essays, his influence over the past 60 years cannot be underestimated. In this memoir he tells for the first time of how his experiences shaped his working life and the dualities he navigated: Jewish/Polish, Polish/British and later, Practice/Scholarship. He spent most of his professional life between the US and UK. Working both as a designer and a writer, his ideas and projects have impacted the thinking of architects from the 1960s to the present.
