

## Login instructions for the Architect's Journal Buildings Library (AJBL)



The AJ Buildings Library showcases thousands of exemplar projects, most from the last 20 years but including major projects back to 1900.

Each project featured in the library includes full project data and comprehensive architectural photographs and drawings (plans, elevation, section) – all provided at high resolution. There is also a large number of working details.

Drawings can be downloaded and printed out to their original scale. NB Vector pdfs and CAD files are not available for download and all copyrighted images are protected.

### REGISTRATION

For the registration only, you need to be on-site and connected to the AA Wi-Fi.


